3-5 Year Olds

Beyond the Coral Reef will focus on exploring sea life and its many wonderful creatures.

My Favorite Tune will allow participants to sing along to their favorite tunes and learn new songs.

Young at Art will allow youth to express themselves through different art activities.

Safari Adventure will involve exploring animals that live in the jungle and rainforest.

Blast into Space will focus on the study of stars and planets.

Going Buggy will offer youth the chance to learn about insects.

Zany Zoo will involve exploring zoo life with animals and their babies.

Down on the Farm will offer youth a chance to learn about farm animals and how a farm works.

6-9 Year Olds + 10-13 Year Olds

Art-rageous will focus on a variety of activities such as painting, drawing, creative projects and more.

Animal Planet will allow campers to visit sites such as the Serpentarium, Waccatee Zoo, and Alligator Adventure

Funology will offer activities like bowling, skating, and putt-putt.

Island Explorer will allow campers to explore sites on the Island and participate in activities like crabbing and putt-putt.

Anything Goes will offer a variety of activities like ice skating, roller skating, and visiting the aquarium.

Splash Bash will allow participants to participate in different water activities and visit sites like Jungle Rapids.

TEAM: Together Everyone Achieves More will give participants a chance to participate in team building activities and visit sites like Maze Mania.

Camp Funtastic will introduce youth to a variety of activities like kite flying, roller skating, and rock climbing.

Several of our day camps are art intensive and are based on visual and performing arts. These camps are supported with a grant from the Brunswick Arts Council.

Sports Camps

Golf Camp will teach campers concepts such as chipping, putting, driving, club selection, and etiquette. South Brunswick High School golf coach, Gene Doan, will lead the camp. Participants are encouraged to bring their own clubs, but it is not required.

Skate Camp is for skateboarders only. Learn to ollie, grind, kick-flip, and master the ramps at the OI Sk8 Park. Instructors will start with the basics and teach all levels of skateboarders how to master various skills. The camp will meet at the OI Sk8 Park.



Fishing Camp will allow youth to learn how to fish in the coastal salt waters around Oak Island. Skills include: tackle basics, tying knots, cleaning fish, homemade tackle, pier fishing, surf fishing, and more. Campers are encouraged to bring their fishing rods. Camps meet at the Recreation Center.

The British Challenge Soccer Camp is a dynamic camp for all levels of players. It is also the #1 soccer camp in Canada and the US! Professional coaches from around the world will make soccer fun while teaching new skills, and player development. Camp will meet at Smithville Park.



Basketball Camp-Join SBHS coach Norman McDuffie and other qualified staff as they teach quality fundamentals and strategy for basketball. Participants will learn dribbling, passing, shooting, offense, and defense skills and more. Camp to be held at SBHS. Transportation from Oak Island will be available. Co-sponsored with SBHS.

Baseball Camp will teach the fundamental strategies of baseball and softball. The camp is co-sponsored by SBHS and led by varsity baseball coach Lee Shelton and other qualified staff. The camp will teach skills such as how to field, hit, run bases, pitch, and slide. This camp will be held at Smith Park.

Sailing Camp will be co-sponsored with the Cape Fear Yacht Club and their members. This course will introduce youth to the fun sport of sailing through both classroom education and hands-on sailing in the Dutchman's Creek area. Trained sailing instructors will lead 35 hours of the US Sail learn-to-sail program and participants will experience hands-on sailing in one person optimist dinghies. At the end of the program campers will have learned boating basics, sailing skills, basic rigging, and completed the beginner level in the US Sail Certification.
