## 3-5 Year Olds

**Under the Sea** will focus on exploring sea life and its many wonderful creatures.

**Ahoy Matey** will focus on the adventures of finding the pirates' hidden treasure.

**Groovy Tunes** will involve singing along to your favorite tunes and learning new songs.

**Picasso's Little Helpers** will allow youth to express themselves through different art activities.

**Safari Adventure** will focus on exploring animals that live in the jungle and rainforest.

**Beyond the Moon** will offer youth the chance to learn about stars and planets.

**Going Buggy** will involve learning about insects.

**Zany Zoo** will focus on learning about zoo life with animals and their babies.

**Down on the Ranch** will focus on farm animals and how a farm works.

## 6-13 Year Olds

**The Great Outdoors** will allow campers to participate in different activities each day like swimming and kayaking.



**Win or Lose-We're Having Fun** will focus on activities such as roller skating and team challenge activities.

**The World of Recycled Art** will introduce youth to green initiatives and constructing projects from recycled materials.

**Camp Funtastic** will allow campers to explore a variety of activities like roller skating and water activities.

**It's A Mystery** will offer activities such as ice skating and zoo trips.

**Explore the Floor of our World** will focus on activities like looking for animal tracks and exploring marshes.

**I've Got Skilz** will encourage youth to exhibit their skills in areas including sports, hobbies, and activities.

**Look What I Can Do** will allow youth to participate in a variety of activities such as painting, drawing, creative projects and more.

Several of our day camps are art intensive and are based on visual and performing arts. These camps are supported with a grant from the Brunswick Arts Council.

## Sports Camps



**Golf Camp** will teach campers concepts such as chipping, putting, driving, club selection, and etiquette. South Brunswick High School golf coach, Gene Doan, will lead the camp. Participants are encouraged to bring their own clubs, but it is not required. Camp will meet at various local golf courses. A schedule will be given out prior to the start of camp.

**Skate Camp** is for skateboarders only. Learn to ollie, grind, kick-flip, and master the ramps at the OI Sk8 Park. Instructors will start with the basics and teach all levels of skateboarders how to master various skills. The camp will meet at the OI Sk8 Park.

**Fishing Camp** will allow youth to learn how to fish in the coastal salt waters around Oak Island. Skills include: tackle basics, tying knots, cleaning fish, homemade tackle, pier fishing, surf fishing, and more. Campers are encouraged to bring their fishing rods. Fishing rods will be provided to campers who do not have their own. Camps meet at the Recreation Center. Co-sponsored with Oak Island Fishing Club.

**The British Challenge Soccer Camp** is a dynamic camp for all levels of players. It is also the #1 soccer camp in Canada and the US! Professional coaches from around the world will make soccer fun while teaching new skills and player development. Camp will meet at Smithville Park.

**Tennis Camp** is a joint effort between OIPRD and RDU Tennis. In this high quality tennis camp, participants will learn the basic skills of tennis mixed into exciting games and drills designed to motivate youth. Camp runs M-Th. Friday is a rain make-up day. All equipment will be provided.



**Sailing Camp** will be co-sponsored with the Cape Fear Yacht Club and their members. This course will introduce youth to the fun sport of sailing through both classroom education and hands-on sailing in the Dutchman's Creek area. Trained sailing instructors will lead 35 hours of the US Sail learn-to-sail program and participants will experience hands-on sailing in one person Optimist dinghies. At the end of the program campers will have learned boating basics, sailing skills, basic rigging, and completed the beginner level in the US Sail Certification.



**Surf Camp**— Oak Island Parks and Recreation has teamed with Indo Jax Surf School to offer this high quality experience of surfing. All instructors are certified professionals and have their lifeguard and CPR certifications. The instructor ratio is 3:1 insuring that you will receive the most knowledgeable and comprehensive instruction available. Each day's lesson will last 2.5 hours. All equipment will be provided.

**Wonderland Horseback Riding Camp**—Learn equestrian care and how to ride. Students receive English Hunt Seat instruction on an individual and group level.
