The Town of Oak would like to invite you to enjoy a round of golf on the areas only PAR 3 course. The Course is located in South Harbour Village, across from the Brunswick County Airport-4188 Vanessa Drive-454-0905.

South Harbour Golf Links is an 18 hole, PAR 3 course that is designed to be enjoyable for all skill levels- it is enticing for the avid golfer and encouraging for the beginner. The course features three tees, is 1951 yards from the back tees and has sand traps and water hazards. Whether working on perfecting your short game, or taking the family out for a round, South Harbour appeals to all.

Do not have four or five hours to play a round of golf, then a two hour round at South Harbour might be just the ticket. Do not want to pay \$75 for a round, then our \$11 to \$18 dollar green fees might be more inviting. For a little more than the cost of putt-putt or a bucket of balls at the driving range, you can walk 18 challenging, yet fun holes of golf. Electric and pull carts are also available, as well as club rentals. Youth under 14 receive free club rentals as part of the "Sticks for Kids" program. The Pro Shop has merchandise, equipment, supplies as well as refreshments.

The course is currently open daily from 7am-7pm- yearly memberships are available, as well as corporate and group outings. Come join us "fore" a great day on the links...
