Garbage & Recycling Schedule Change for the Beach Area!

The Town will shift to the SUMMER garbage and recycling collection schedule on May 17th, 2017. This change affects the **BEACH AREA ONLY: OCEAN DR., BEACH DR., DOLPHIN, PELICAN & KINGS LYNN.**

All other areas will remain on the same YEAR-ROUND schedule of pickup. The summer collection schedule for the Beach Area begins May 17th and will continue through September 30th, 2017.

GARBAGE PICKUP: Twice weekly on Wednesday and Saturday (all areas except Ocean Drive, which is Tuesday & Saturday).

RECYCLING PICKUP: Every Saturday.

AREA OF ENFORCEMENT: All homes on Beach Dr., Ocean Dr., Dolphin Dr. and Kings Lynn **ONLY.**
