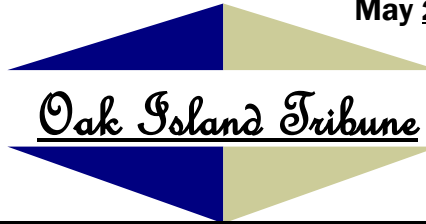

Turtle Season Has Begun!

Turtle Season began on May 1st. If you see a turtle on the beach, stay back and allow her to settle and begin nesting. Be sure to observe quietly from a distance and do not disturb her. Police may be notified if there is a problem, otherwise report the nesting site to the Recreation Department at 278-5518. *Please, NO flash photography.*
